Tournament Sign Up

The Honeybrook Golf Club Tournament Calendar includes a variety of tournaments offering the entire Golf Membership an opportunity to participate. Each event is unique in its description and format. <u>FOR 2024 we will be using Golf Genius as the primary method for Event Sign Up</u>. You may also enter events by calling the ProShop or emailing chris@honeybrookgolf.com.

Tournament Eligibility:

Participants must be a Honeybrook Golf Club Member in good standing (Guest Events excluded). Men shall play the Tournament designated tees. There is a Super Senior option when offered, whereas a Male player age 65 or older may play the yellow tees if the <u>combination of their age and handicap equals 80 or greater</u>. Appropriate handicap adjustment will apply. Women age 65 or older will be able to play the Lt Blue tees if the <u>combination of their age and handicap equals 80 or greater</u>. Appropriate handicap adjustment will apply.

Match Play Deadlines *Very Important*

The Club is proud to offer Match Play events to the Membership. In order to conduct these events in a professional manner, <u>all matches must be completed ON (or Before if mutually agreed) the designated deadline dates.</u>

Golf Shop tournament credit

Many of the events conducted at the Club result in the winners receiving Golf Shop Tournament Credit. Tournament Credit will only be available for Golf Shop merchandise purchases. Credit or certificates may not be transferred from one account to another. Also, it must be used towards future purchases. Certificates may not be used towards Account Balances or Food and Beverage.

The United States Golf Association (USGA) rules govern all play except where modified by local rules. Questions and disputes regarding the rules are handled by the Golf Professional Staff.

Welcome to 2024 Honeybrook Golf Club Member Tournaments.

The processes for our Tournaments and events are as follows:

- 1) Registration for events will be offered primarily through Golf Genius. Call-ins and email entry may also be available. All sign-up options will have a designated cut-off time.
- 2) Events will incur an Entry Fee which shall cover the various aspects of the event including prizes.
- - a. Golfers will be responsible for their Greens Fees for events compatible with their Membership package.
 - b. Players will be responsible how the player chooses to get their equipment around the golf course (i.e. Cart, Cart Package etc.) and applicable fees.
- 4) Food and Beverage MAY and will be part of certain Tournaments.
- 5) Tie Breakers! Other than Sudden Death Playoffs Ties will be decided using the USGA Tie Breaker recommendations based on the format of the event. Ties for 2nd, 3rd etc shall split.
- 6) The Member-Guest Invitational shall be a "stand alone" event that will offer a weekend "package". Specific details will be provided at a later date.
- 7) PLEASE READ CAREFULLY THE INFORMATION SHEETS regarding THE PIERSOL CUP and TEAM MATCH PLAY. The Committee has made some changes to these events.



Piersol Cup

(Tournament of Champions Event)

NEW FORMAT

This event is an individual match play championship and is open to all Adult male and female members in good standing.

The Match Play field shall consist of 16 Players and will be determined through an 18 hole NET QUALIFYING round. The LOWEST 15 NET Scores from qualifying plus the Defending Champion will determine the Match Play field.

The qualifying round must be played on either May 31, June 1 or 2. All qualifiers MUST have their scorecard attested by another person but not necessarily one that is qualifying. USGA Rules of Stroke play shall be used for qualifying. *95% of Course Handicap shall be used*. Match Play rounds will use the USGA Rules of Match Play. Matches will be played net off from the player with the lower handicap. Handicap revisions shall be on the date of the Match.

EACH ROUND IS TO BE

PLAYED ON THE DESIGNATED DATE unless the players mutually agree to play BEFORE the designated date.

MATCHES SHALL BE PLAYED on the DATE UNLESS THE GOLF COURSE IS DEEMED UNPLAYABLE. If a player is not able to play on schedule, they shall forfeit.

Matches will be played during Member Matches. Failure to make tee time results in forfeit. All Play shall be from the White Tees for Men and the Red Tees for Women.

Team Match Play Championship

This event is a Better Ball of Partners match play championship and is open to all Adult male and female members in good standing.

The Match Play field shall consist of 8 Teams and will be determined through an 18 hole NET QUALIFYING round of Better Ball. The LOWEST 7 NET Scores from qualifying plus the Defending Champions will determine the Match Play field.

The qualifying round must be played on either June 7, 8 or 9. All qualifiers MUST have their scorecard attested by another person but not necessarily one that is qualifying. USGA Rules of Stroke play shall be used for qualifying. **85% of course handicap shall be used.**Match Play rounds will use the USGA Rules of Match Play. Matches will be played net off of the player in the group with the lowest handicap. Handicap revisions shall be on the date of the Match. All Play shall be from the White Tees for Men and the Red Tees for Women.

EACH ROUND IS TO BE

PLAYED ON THE DESIGNATED DATE unless the players mutually agree to play BEFORE the designated date.

MATCHES SHALL BE PLAYED on the DATE UNLESS THE GOLF COURSE IS DEEMED UNPLAYABLE. If the player is not able to play on schedule, they shall forfeit.

Play On dates will be with in Member Matches. If a team misses their time, They Forfeit. All Play shall be from the White Tees for Men and the Red Tees for Women Qualifying June 7, 8, 9. One Round Better Ball NET 18 Hole score
